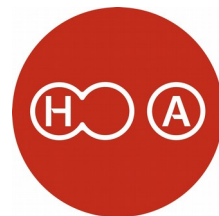

1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The Jihlavský ježek SYS will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2025, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Synchronized Skating, the relevant ISU Communications and the rules of CSFA Regulations for season 2025/2026.

The categories Pre Juvenile, Juvenile and Non-ISU Basic Novice will be according to the rules of the ISU for Basic Novice and the specific regulations contained in this announcement. The Free Skating Elements and Requirements to be skated for Season 2025/26 are listed in ISU Communication 2692. The Well Balanced Program for Adult will be according to the ISU Technical Requirements for Adult. Program for Mini Synchro will be according to interclub technical requirements, please see below.

Participation in the Jihlavský ježek SYS is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in this announcement and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

2. TECHNICAL DATA

PLACE **Rink 1: Horácká Multifunctional Arena (HMA), Tolstého 23, 58601 Jihlava, Czechia**
Rink 2: Zimáček – Public Icesport Centre, Tolstého 23, Jihlava, Czechia

Categories:

MINI SYNCHRO Team shall consist of 6-16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. All skaters must have not reached the age of 9 before July 1, 2025*. 80% of team must have not competed in previous season in any other competition than Mini Synchro. Ice coverage requirement must be 50% of the rink. Elements: block, line, circle, wheel, intersections/moves (5 obligatory)

Free Skating 2.00 min (+ / - 10 sec)

Maximum level to be called will be level 2 for element and features, except SySp max. will be level 1 according to the current WBP communication.

PRE JUVENILE Team shall consist of 8-16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. All skaters must have not reached the age of 11 before July 1, 2025*.

Free Skating 3.00 min (+ / - 10 sec)

Maximum level to be called will be level 3 for element and features, except SySp max. will be level 1 according to the current WBP communication.



JUVENILE	Team	shall consist of 8-16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. All skaters must have not reached the age of 13 before July 1, 2025*.
	Free Skating	3.00 min (+ / - 10 sec) Maximum level to be called will be level 3 for element and features, except SySp max. will be level 1 according to the current WBP communication.

NON ISU BASIC NOVICE	Team	shall consist of 8-16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. All skaters must have reached at least the age of 10, but not have reached the age of 16 before July 1, 2025*.
	Free Skating	Free Skating: 3.00 min (+ / - 10 sec)

*** Age limit:**

For the max **3 skaters** an age deviation of +/-2 years is permitted for the categories Mini, Pre Juvenile, Juvenile and Non-ISU Basic Novice.

MIXED AGE	Team	shall consist of 8-16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. No age limit.
	Free Skating	3.30 min (+ / - 10 sec)

ADULT	Team	shall consist of 8-16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. All skaters must have reached at least the age of 18 before July 1, 2025. At least 50% of the team must have reached the age of 23 before July 1, 2025. The 50% rule applies according to the number of skaters which are skating the free skating.

3. ENTRIES

General

All entries have to be sent to the Organizing Committee (OC) of the 28th **Jihlavský ježek SYS 2025**.

Preliminary Entries

The preliminary entry form must be submitted no later than Tuesday **September 30, 2025 (Form 1)**

Final Entry

Entries of Teams

All final entries and nominations must be submitted to the OC no later than **Friday, October 31, 2025**.

Entries of Judges

The Referees, Technical Specialists, Technical Controllers, Data and Replay Operators will be nominated by the Organizing Committee. Expenses for travel, accommodation and meals for Referees, Technical Specialists, Technical Controllers, Data and Replay Operators will be covered by the OC.

Entries of Team Members

Official entries of Team Leaders, Assistant Team Leaders, Team Officials, Team Medical Staff and Coaches and the partner or relative of a Judge will be accepted. Accreditation will be provided to those who are officially accepted by the Organizer.

The names of all team members must be submitted and must reach the Organizing Committee not later than: **Friday, October 31, 2025 (Form 2)**

Entry Fee

With the entry to the competition, the entry fee must be paid as follows:

500.00 € per Team / 12 500,- CZK

The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason.

Please note, the transfer of the entry fee is due without further invoice. The entry fee payment does not include any extra practice ice nor any offered meals at the competition.

7. MUSIC

In accordance with Rule 823 in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules for Synchronized Skating, the team music shall be submitted to the OC as follows:

All teams shall furnish competition music of excellent quality as MP3 file format via e-mail to kraso@hcdukla.cz. The respective e-mail should only contain one music file. The subject of the e-mail and the file must be clearly indicated and labeled in the following format:

<Category>_<Nation>_<Team Name>_<Segment: SP or FS>_<Running Time>

Example:

JUV_CZE_Team Name_FS_3.08

Music files are requested to be uploaded no later than **Friday, October 31, 2025** [\(Form 6\)](#)

Additionally, each team shall bring their competition music on a clearly labeled USB drive as a backup. One USB drive for each program. The music must be submitted by the Team Manager or Team Leader at the time of registration. All music must be clearly indicated with the name of the team and must show the exact running time of the music (not skating time). The titles, composers and orchestras of the music to be used for the Short Program and Free Skating must all be listed for each team on the Official Music and Press Information Form in the ISU Portal.

If music information is not complete and/or the music is not provided, accreditation will not be given.

8. PRACTICE

The official practice of all categories will start at 7 a.m. / 10 minutes per program.

Unofficial Extra Practice

Extra practice ice will only be available on the special request on Friday. 20 min / 60,- EUR.

9. ARRIVAL OF PARTICIPANTS / TEAMS

The nearest parking place to HMA for buses is ICOM Bus Station, please reserve per email on kraso@hcdukla.cz .(Form 8) For your cars please use the underground HMA garage.

The usual parking place by Railway Station is due to reconstruction not available at the moment.

10. ACCREDITATION

The official accreditation for Teams is planned at the **HMA, Friday, December 5, 2025 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. and Saturday, December 6, 2025 from 7 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.**

Accreditation as a Team Member will be given to all entered Judges, Competitors and Team Leaders (1 per country), Team Managers (1 per Team), Official Coaches (2 per Team), Team Medical Persons (1 Team Doctor and 1 Team Physiotherapist will be accepted as the Team Medical Staff – OC will request a certificate prior to accreditation) Team Service Staff (2 per Team).

Accreditation will be given to appointed Event Officials and Guests.

11. DRAW

The official draws for the competition will be done electronically on Wednesday, December 3, 2025. The starting order will be published on the competition website after the draw.

12. PRESENTATION OF MEDALS AND PRIZES

Final ceremony is determined for all participants on ice.

13. MEETINGS FOR EVENT OFFICIALS AND JUDGES

Technical panel will be present within official practices. Panel of judges will be invited by the referee.

14. INFORMATION AND VARIOUS

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to cancel the competition after the closing date if restrictions imposed by the public health authorities or government regulations prohibit or make it untenable to hold the competition. In this case, the OC will refund 90 percent of the entry fee.
